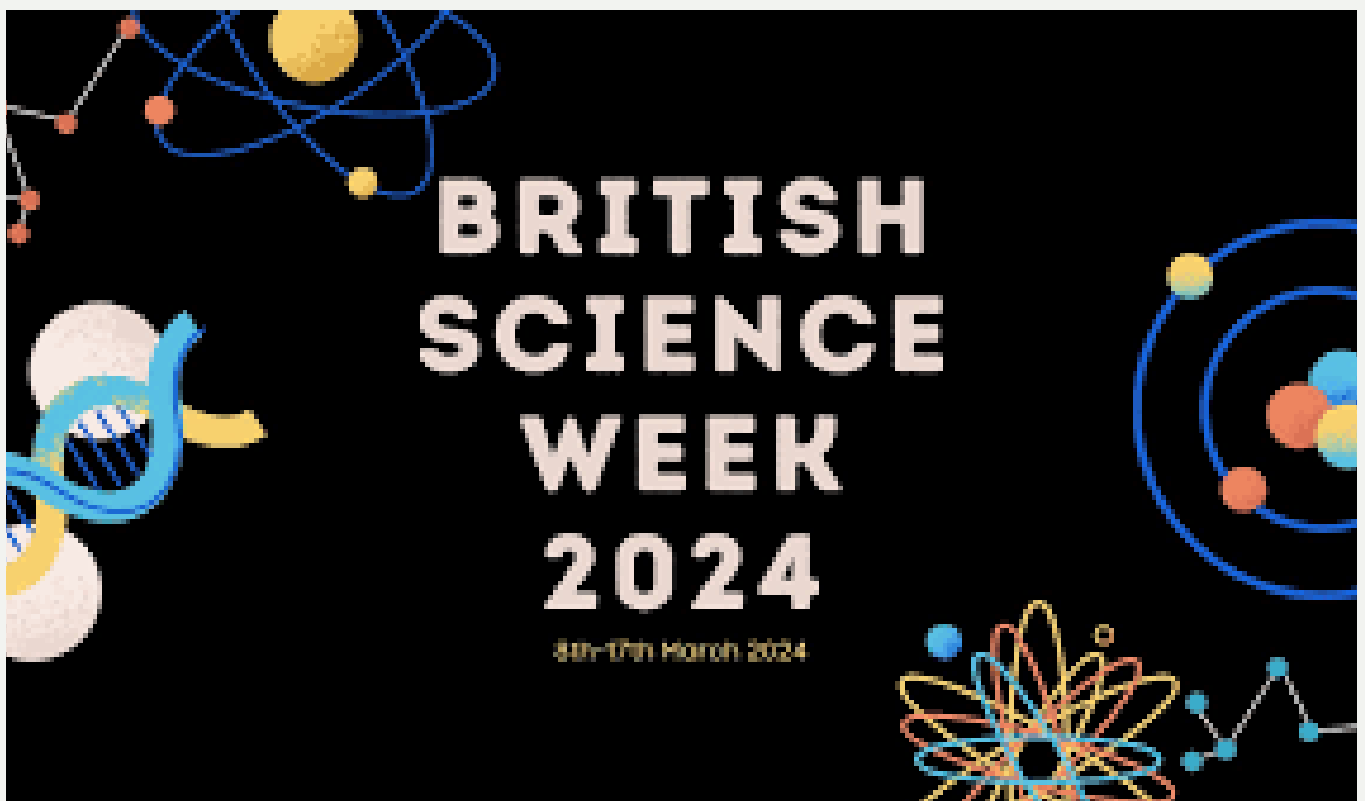


RED NOSE DAY
